About Us

St Paul's College is a residential academic community within the University of Sydney. Founded in 1856 as an Anglican college, it is the oldest college in Australia. The College sits amidst beautiful grounds and gardens at the heart of the University; its original sandstone buildings, designed by Edmund Blacket, are among the finest neo-Gothic buildings in Australia.

St Paul's aspires today to be a modern, internationally-minded, outward-looking Australian Anglican college: a place where students, academic staff and visitors – reflecting the full spectrum of university life – interact, grow and learn from one another in a mutually supportive residential academic environment.

An Expanding Vision

St Paul's College is building upon its distinguished heritage by creating a distinctive new **Graduate House** community for postgraduate students and academics, both women and men, from Australia and around the world.

The Graduate House community, to be made up of 140 residents, opens in January 2019 with the aim of being "Australia's leading graduate community for women and men".

Residents of Graduate House will enjoy a unique experience of university life, in a beautiful physical environment in the "Oxbridge" style, with an unparalleled combination of facilities and programmes.

The new Graduate House facilities will be suitable for independent-style living, with high quality academic and student studio apartments, while also having access to substantial communal facilities. Some accommodation will be suitable for couples.



Join a world-class collegiate community

Led by the Warden (Head of College) and the Dean of Graduate House, the initial residents will have the opportunity to be part of the creation of Australia's leading graduate community for women and men.

Just as is offered in St Paul's College as a whole, Graduate House offers students and academics the opportunity to integrate learning and living, with a focus on activities that are academic, more broadly intellectual, cultural, spiritual, sporting, community service, and social. The fellowship of friends and the exhilaration of living and learning together are at the heart of the College experience.

Specifically, Graduate House will be founded upon interdisciplinary interaction and distinctive academic leadership

and it will be complementary to the University's growing focus on higher degrees, postgraduate studies and interdisciplinary research centres.

St Paul's College and its Graduate House will be two communities within the one collegiate environment, sitting side-by-side at the heart of the University of Sydney. Whilst related by identity and affiliation, each community will offer distinctive opportunities and experiences reflecting the full spectrum of university life.

Graduate House will provide unique opportunities for collaboration and integration amongst its members, within and across academic disciplines – a superb environment in which to be a graduate student or academic.

Accommodation and Facilities

Graduate House will have state-of-the-art accommodation in two wings: the **Academic Wing** and the **Student Wing**.

Bedrooms are fully furnished with bed (queen size in most rooms), wardrobe, desk, lounge and TV, and include ensuite bathrooms, air-conditioning, kitchenette (including cooktop, small fridge and separate sink), Wi-Fi and security access.

The **Academic Wing** is ideal for University academic and clinical staff, post-doctoral researchers, visiting scholars and guests, and is suitable for couples. The wing has a dedicated building entry lobby and elevator, and includes

21 superior academic apartments and studios with an average size of 40-44 sqm.

The **Student Wing** is ideal for graduate coursework students, Masters and PhD research students, post-doctoral researchers, part-time coursework students and combined degree students already holding a first degree. The wing has a dedicated building entry lobby and elevator, and includes **116 bedrooms** in a range of sizes and configurations: **12 x 1-bedroom apartments** (38-41 sqm) which are suitable for couples; **8 x 2-bedroom apartments** for sharing (50-57 sqm); **72 standard studios** (28-34 sqm); and **16 attic studios** (19 sqm). Four of the standard studios are wheelchair-accessible.



The Graduate House building has full security and CCTV coverage.

Common facilities include:

- Refectory and Servery
- Common (lounge) room and Dining room on Ground level
- Rooftop common room and terrace, with communal cooking facilities incl. outdoor BBQ and fire place
- Common rooms with cooking facilities on typical floors
- Graduate Garden
- Laundry



Across the wider St Paul's College campus, Graduate House residents will have access to:

- Study Centre and Library (new)
- Gymnasium (new)
- Music Centre (new)
- College Oval
- Chapel
- College Bar
- Occasional use of common facilities in the existing College buildings

Offering

Residency is available on an annual or per semester basis. Short-term options are also available for guests.

Location

Graduate House is conveniently located at the heart of the University of Sydney and close to the Sydney CBD.

The street address is 9 City Road, Camperdown. City Road is a major arterial route connecting the Sydney CBD with the inner south-west suburbs and serviced by major bus routes. One of Sydney's major railway stations at Redfern is

within an easy 15 min walk. Also within walking distance are cosmopolitan areas such as Newtown, Glebe, Darlington and Chippendale, replete with cafes, restaurants and many other retail opportunities.

Being at the heart of the University's Camperdown campus, most teaching, research, faculty, library, sporting and recreational facilities are a short walk from Graduate House. The University's sport and fitness facilities, including gymnasium, 50m indoor swimming pool, tennis courts and indoor basketball courts are a 5 min walk away. One of Sydney's most prestigious teaching hospitals, Royal Prince Alfred Hospital, is also within walking distance.

The College is within reach of hundreds of great Sydney attractions including the iconic Sydney Opera House and Sydney Harbour.
