Notes:

This schedule is to be read in conjunction with the *Agreement: Fees and Other Charges*, signed upon commencement and as updated from time to time.

Fees and charges are inclusive of GST where applicable.

Semester 1 2021 Residency Fees are for 20 weeks from Sunday 20 February 2022 (12pm) to Saturday 09 July 2022 (10am).

Semester 2 2021 Residency Fees are for 20 weeks from Sunday 10 July 2022 (12pm) to Monday 28 November 2022 (10am).

Students from other universities contract to reside in College for the dates above. If their study dates differ, students should apply to remain beyond their contract dates.

Students may apply to remain beyond their contract dates using the appropriate online form. This will be subject to availability and may require the student to move to a different room. Applications are also subject to the approval of the Registrar.

Residency Fees plus other relevant fees and charges are payable semi-annually in full, 10 days prior to commencement of the relevant semester. Arrangements to pay by monthly instalments (using direct debit only) must be made with the College's Finance team 10 days prior to commencement of the relevant semester. All vacation charges are to be paid upfront before commencement of vacation stay.

Overdue accounts will incur administration charges of \$20 per month (including GST) for each \$1,000 or part thereof.

Residency Fees are payable to St Paul's College and are subject to change prior to commencement of residency at the discretion of the College. The College reserves the right to impose a credit card surcharge of 1% for all credit card payments.
