The Honourable Lloyd Waddy AM RFD KC was in College from 1958-1961, whilst studying Law at the University of Sydney. He was highly involved in many areas of both the College and the University at large: debating, drama, chapel, Students' Club Committee, University Revue and Air Cadets. Lloyd became a barrister in 1963, a QC in 1988, and a Justice of the Family Court in 1998. Lloyd continued to contribute significantly to College after he left: founder and director of Victoriana!, Vice-President of the St Paul's College Union, and a Fellow and Chairman of Council. As founder and Vice-Chairman of the St Paul's College Foundation, his dedication to securing the College's future, and fostering scholarships has left an indelible mark. Additionally, Lloyd's long involvement in the cherished annual Victoriana! performances (director and MC for 34 years) has enriched the cultural tapestry of St. Paul's College.
