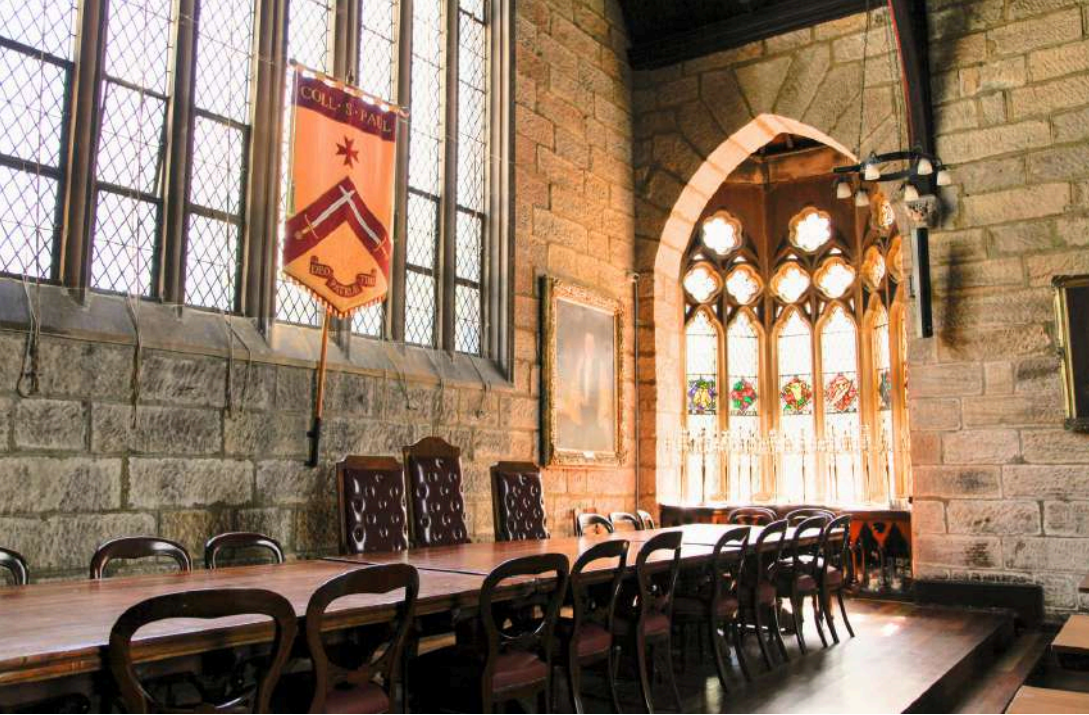
THE MAIN DINING HALL

This heritage venue can accommodate 180 guests for lunch or dinner, and 150 for a cocktail reception. The Dining Hall offers a classic venue situated near the expansive Quadrangle lawns, ideal for pre-dinner drinks or photography.

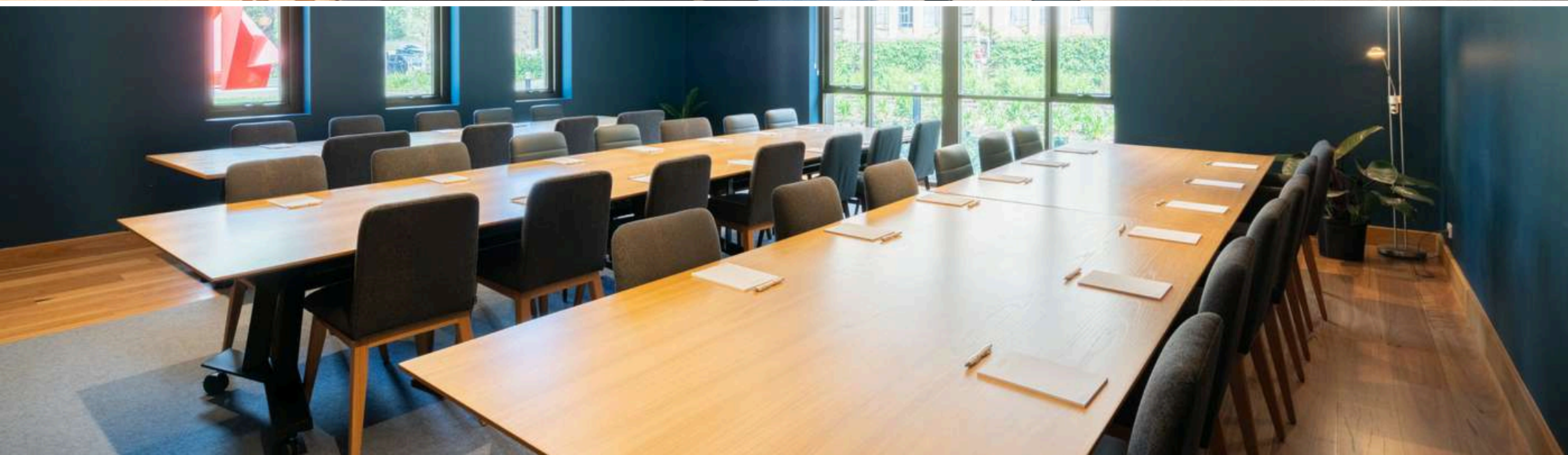
